Psalm 110 - (pt. 2) - Intercession and Armageddon

<u>Intro</u> – Great Commission and Ascension. The Ascension doesn't get the same attention as other events Matt. 28:18-"All authority in.....has been given to Me." Jesus claims <u>all</u> authority, gives a commission and ascends to His throne to exercise that authority. Ps 110 pre-records this glorious event. Psalm 110 is the most quoted and referenced OT passage in the NT – over 30+ times! (the middle middle of Bible) This Psalm is a highpoint in prophecy about The Christ and one in which we should pay careful attention. And Ps. 110 doesn't present a "milquetoast messiah". The JESUS of scripture is often different than the "jesus" of popular sermons (beware). Ps 110 shows Jesus as HE is - King of kings and Lord of lords.

Review - This Psalm starts with God talking to God - The Father promises The Son some things

- "Sit at My right Hand" Jesus ascended to the place of Power it is a relaxed reign sits
- "Enemies at footstool" "rule in midst of enemies" Jesus rules over rebels/unrepentant
- Strong scepter no power can stop Christ, His gospel (success of G Commission) or His coming While He is reigning He is interceding (praying) and He is coming! Odd title- Intercession & Armageddon

INTERCESSION

- 1. Ps. 110:4 the Psalm begins with God talking to God. Here in vs. 4 God swears to God.
 - a. God takes and oath witnesses take an oath/Presidential oath on Bible-higher auth.
 - i. no one greater for God to swear by so He swears by Himself (Heb. 6:13)
 - b. God swears and God cannot lie (Titus 1:2) ironclad double guarantee
- 2. "And will not change His mind"

 The Father swears to the Son and it is unalterable
 - a. God doesn't lie and there is no loophole. This oath is a promised eternal reality
 - i. Triple guarantee oath/not lie/won't change
- 3. "You are priest forever"
 - a. God the Father promises God the Son a Priesthood and Eternal Priesthood
 - b. The Son of God would be the only, and eternal, "go between" between God and men
 - c. A priest represents people before God sacrifices and supplications
 - d. The Father swears that no one will come to Him except through His Son the Priest
 - i. 1 Timothy 2:5 Acts 4:12 John 14:6 (Aaron's rod that budded)
- 4. According to the order of Melchizedek (priesthood of higher order than Aaron)
 - a. Mel is a mysterious OT figure. King of Salem and Priest of the Most High God
 - b. Without genealogy Mel was constant King and perpetual Priest (no end)
 - i. Mel is a fitting type and pre-figure of Christ (if not Christ Himself)
- 5. Jesus is an eternal King with and eternal Priesthood with promised success on God's oath
 - a. This is great news for us! Your salvation is as good as the Priest that got it for you
 - b. Your salvation will last as long as your Priests work & endure only while your King rules
 - c. Don't trust in Popes they come and go. Denominations don't endure, pastors fail and fall, preachers promise but don't deliver, personal decisions are precarious at best...but Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today &forever. He and His work endure forever!

- 6. The problem with earthly priest is they don't last/work doesn't endure. Not so with Jesus Christ
 - a. Heb. 5:9 Heb. 7:21-28 oath, guarantee, permanent, save forever, once
- 7. Part of Jesus' continuing work in His office as High Priest is that He prays for us
 - a. He is sitting at the right hand (but not just sitting) He reigns & He prays to the Father
 - i. Heb. 7:25 Rom. 8:33-34 1 John 2:1 an Advocate with the Father
 - b. Do you ever wonder if you will make it to the end of your faith? Can I endure and fight the good fight...what if I lose? What about my besetting sins? What about my failure?
 - c. We will make it to the end of our faith because Jesus has prayed, and is praying, for us!
 - i. Consider the difference between Peter and Judas one betrayed for 30 pcs of silver, the other denied 3 times with an oath/curses. What is the difference?
 - d. Jesus told Judas after his deceitful "not I?" "...you have said it yourself" (Matt. 26:25)
 - i. "gave it to Judas...Satan entered...what you do, do quickly" (John 13:26-27)
 - e. Jesus told Peter Luke 22:31-32 "...Satan has asked... I have prayed...when you return
 - f. What made the difference between Peter and Judas? JESUS! Peter had a Priest!

 An Effectual Priest on the oath of God that His work works, that His sacrifice saves,

 His prayers are answered, His Advocacy is heard, His intercession is effectual.
 - g. Do you have such a Priest today? Powerful/Perpetual/Effectual

ARMAGEDDON

Ps. 110:5-7 - Armageddon and the 2nd coming of the King Priest. The Consummation of the ages

- 110:5-6 gets a little gory. Jesus is not a milquetoast messiah or a puny priest
 - o Melchizedek was King of Righteousness / Peace introduced after slaughter of kings
 - Jesus is a King Priest in this same order
 Perpetual and Powerful
- God promises His Son Jesus that:
 - That He is Lord
 - o That He will have a day of wrath in which He will shatter kings (Is. 24:21-23; Rev. 17:14)
 - Jesus will judge the nations (Matt. 25:31ff)
 - Jesus will fill the nations with corpses
- This has reference to our LORD's 2nd coming and the battle of Armageddon
 - o Rev. 19:11-21 Jesus is the Righteous and Just Judge
 - o There is a day for the wrath of the Lamb Rev. 6:15-17
 - Flee from the wrath of the Lamb to the sacrifice of the Lamb!
 - Jesus is Priest Jesus is the Sacrifice Jesus is the Advocate
- 110:7 indicates that this Powerful Perpetual King Priest will be present in this earth
 - His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives and it will split apart
 Zech. 14:4
 - He will drink from the brook by the wayside
 - o Jesus drank with His disciples before He left and He will drink with us when He returns
 - Jesus left and ascended into heaven bodily and He will come back in the same way He
 left Acts 1:11
 In the clouds and bodily
 Anyone thirsty?
 - We will have peace when the King of Peace comes.
 Look up for our redemption...
