Dan. 2:40-45 - L.O.T.H. - Governmental - Gov. is not God

Intro- today= LORD's day worldwide; Independence Day nationwide; & *Out of order day* churchwide. Suppose to have Supper today but moved to next week because of holiday & Today's sermon belongs in series that we finished weeks ago but circumstances bumped this one out of order while we were LOTH.

- Mother/Fathers day leaders have a responsibility to prepare their people/families for the evil day
 1 Cor. 16:13 we need to be prepared spiritually, psychologically and relationally
- Societal- cultural trends we are to expect days of Noah and Sodom and Gomorrah hide/pride
- Environmental events in "nature" that are predictors. Earth/sea/wild weather/heavens/ light/dark
- Ecclesiastical churchical changes Deception Desertion Persecution Mission
- Today we note some Governmental issues that the inspired text warns us of. Attempted Union;
 Continual Confrontation; Forced Assimilation; Worldwide Deception; Coming Consummation
 - o all governments are established by God but never forget that government is not God.

<u>ATTEMPTED UNION</u> governments will try to unify but they won't quite codify or mix well

- 1. not uncommon to hear Christians talk about a coming global government (I? but it is a quest)
 - a. "Imagine" yearning for a utopia "building a ladder to place that doesn't (cant) exist"
 - b. Back to Babel God separated us into nations for a reason (separated cells)
 - i. When this world becomes one this world is done
- 2. 10 nation confederacy seen as 10 horns (Daniel 7:23-24; Rev. 13,17) & 10 toes (Daniel 2)
 - a. The 10 toes are made of iron and clay. Dan. 2:42-43 Partly strong and partly brittle
 - i. They are mixed with the seed of men (multi-cultural) Dan. 2:43
 - ii. They won't fully mix together. They can't congeal "will not adhere"

CONTINUAL CONFRONTATION may be a quest for global gov. but will get continual global conflict.

- 1. They may attempt to unite but there will be a continual fight
 - a. Matt. 24:6-7 wars and.....nation will rise against nation and kingdom against....
 - i. Jesus mentions nations and kingdoms in conflict (they won't be one)
 - b. Dan. 9:26c wars and desolations are decreed until the end (world be united in conflict)
 - c. Today is our 245th birthday we have had 17 of those years without war (WarHistory)
 - d. In the last 3421 yrs of history only 268 have been without war (NYT)
 - i. We may have ended our conflict in Afghanistan but I doubt conflict will end
- 2. Coming conflicts
 - a. Ezek. 38:3,5 NKJV nations attacking Israel Rosh (Russia?) Persia, Ethiopia, Libya
 - i. Some interpret 38:6 as being Germany and Turkey ??? (war not go well)
 - b. Jerusalem will be surrounded by armies Luke 21:20; Rev. 11:2; Zech. 12:3; 14:2,12
 - i. Peace Treaty with Israel Dan. 9:27 Temple 2 Thess. 2:4; Matt. 24:15
 - c. Kings from the east will cross the Euphrates River for war Rev. 16:12
 - d. The 10 nation confederation will fight against the great city that rules over the earth
 - i. Beauty & the Beast will battle. Mystery Babylon will fall in one hour Rev. 17-18

FORCED ASSIMILATION - not a one world government system but a one world economic system

- 1. Rev. 13:16-17 there is a mandatory money mark coming
 - a. Compelled to conform if one is to participate in the economy "to buy or sell"
 - b. Forced compliance. Resistance is futile your will be assimilated...or else
 - i. Comply or die excluded from economy /on wrong side of history
- 2. Governments will enforce a forced homage to an image (Rev. 13:14-15)
 - a. Forced idolatry (like in Daniel 3 fiery furnace) bow the knee to government image
 - b. We have coming our way a Government imposed idolatry and tightly controlled economy
 - c. Not hard to imagine what a totalitarian government could do with current technology
 - i. We have just experience rapid change & what can be imposed on us in a crisis
- 3. all governments are established by God but government is not God
 - a. our pledge of allegianceone nation <u>under God</u>.... God is over government
 - b. Governments can & do exceed their God given boundaries/authority
 - c. When government becomes "god" it is idolatry to comply & Christian duty to dissent
- 4. In early church, Rome required everyone to say, "Caesar is Lord" that is "government is god"
 - a. You could keep all your other gods as long as they were subordinate to government
 - b. Christian wouldn't comply. "Jesus is Lord" "Jesus is God" government is under God
- 5. Christians cannot comply with a government imposed idolatry or a compelled economy
 - a. Coming conflict with government for Christians Rev. 13:7;12:17 Dan. 7:21, 25
 - b. We are to have victory over the image and the money mark. Rev. 15:2
 - c. Beware of the mandatory money mark and a forced homage to an image. Gov. is not God

WORLD WIDE DECEPTION Governments and politicians don't lie to us do they?

- 1. Society is conditioning us now to believe lies. Lies are the language of the day
 - a. Prov. 23:23 if we sell the truth we will buy anything we will buy the lie
 - b. A big lie is coming from big government. Dan. 8:25 "cause deceit to succeed "
 - c. Satan deceives whole world Rev. 12:9. His influence on government leaders compels them to do the same. Rev. 13:14: 19:20 2 Thess, 2:9-11- God seals choice
 - d. The deception will be so great even the elect would succumb... if possible.Matt:24:24-25
- 2. Government will be an anti-christ. A false Christ with a false gospel and even a false resurrection
 - a. A government leader will be "wounded by the sword yet live" Rev. 13:14b
 - i. the world will marvel Rev. 13:3
 - b. The deception is an imitation. A counterfeit Christ, false gospel, resurrection rendition

COMING CONSUMATION

after the imitation there will be the culmination of the ages

- Daniel 2:33-35; 44-45 the Rock of Ages will smash the toes. (step on toes of foes sudden fall)
- Isaiah 9:6-7 Government on His shoulders...no end to the increase of His government
- Rev. 11:15 the kingdoms of this world have become the kingdom of our Lord and His Christ.
- Jesus is the ruler of the kings of the earth now Rev. 1:5
- Jesus will rule with rod of iron when He comes at the consummation Rev. 19:15
 - o Government is not God. Jesus is God Jesus is Lord
- Phil. 2:9-11 every knee will bow and every tongue will confess (Matt. 21:44)
