Phil. 3:1-9 - Communion & Union...or Hyphen?

Intro - Gen. 1:1 – God made the universe...a wide diversity of things that operate in unity – created order. The Church is a universe – a wide diversity of sinners brought to unity in one Savior- a re-created order. One thing that all Christians share is a common love for Christ and shared communion with Him at His Table. Every SONday is the LORD's day but this day we celebrated the LORD's Supper. In the Supper we are reminded of many things – Incarnation, Substitution, Redemption, Pardon...Communion & Union

As we prepare ourselves to fellowship with one another, and with our Redeemer, I want us to remember that as we come to this Table we are to downplay our diversity and embrace our unity. As Christians we have a common identity – and our identity is in Christ- He is our Life! Our created differences are swept into the re-created order – a diversity of sinners brought together into unity around one glorious Savior.

- Years ago I had some sweet fellowship with an individual with whom I had nothing in common
 - o A lot of differences: age, socio-economic, education, occupation, "success", family, we did have a small similarity he had a mansion and I was a man with a son
 - o We had absolutely nothing in common.....except Christ!
 - We were two very distinct sinners redeemed by the same wonderful Savior
 - All our differences made no difference especially around the Ordinance
 - There is a *sameness* to the Supper. Same: elements, portion, place, same time
 - We were one in the Son.
 A common identity despite our differences
- Phil. 3:1-2 Paul wants to safeguard the church and warns of divisive people. He calls them Dogs, evil workers, false circumcision. Jews who were classifying and categorizing Christians
 - o Jude 19 warn of those who cause division (make distinctions) and have not the Spirit
 - Identity politics plays in the world but has no place in the church
- Phil. 3:3 Believers are those who have the Spirit and exhibit two distinct things:
 - o 1 Glory in Christ (Gal. 6:14 God forbid that...) Spirit filled = Christ exalting
 - 2- put no confidence I the flesh (our diverse identities are downplayed)
- Phil 3:4-6 Paul gives his own resume` if he were to play the comparative identity game.
 - o Circumcised the 8th day (special ceremony) Israel (special nation)
 - o Benjamin (a top tribe) Hebrew of Hebrews (top of class)
 - o Pharisee (conservative *originalist* with Law) zeal (no slacker but persecutor)
 - o Legalistic precision he was without reproach a stickler for the law he did the work
 - o Impressive resume` Laudable diversity that set him apart a unique identity
- Phil 3:7 pre-salvation identity he thought was on the + side of the ledger was put on neg. side
 - o His unique diversity and distinction was lost in a Union & Communion with Christ Jesus
- Phil 3:8 Paul puts all his best stuff and unique self on the trash heap it's all rubbish
 - o Isaiah 64:6 our best deeds and unique identity is but dirty diapers
 - All that defines me is dung compared to Christ who is my all in all
 - o Our diverse identities before Christ..... must bow to Christ.....when we come to Christ
- Phil 3:9 Being found in Him... our chief identity is in Christ!
 - Our diversity is swallowed up in His unity We are a universe a re-created order
