## Exodus 20:1-3 - RULE #1

INTRO – Rule #1. Any list has a 1<sup>st,</sup> but the 1<sup>st</sup> is usually foundational. It sets the stage, it's the main thing that all the other things tie into. It is 1<sup>st</sup> not because what follows lacks priority, but the 1<sup>st</sup> does have seniority. This list of 10 has 2 halves (2 tablets). Each half conveys the greatest of all rules which is LOVE. 1<sup>st</sup> half is how to love God. The 2<sup>nd</sup> half is how to love neighbor. The 1<sup>st</sup> rule in the 1<sup>st</sup> half is foundational to loving God. If we are to have any love for God, then Rule #1 has seniority in saying what love for God looks like. These rules are rulers to measure our affection so we can see where we come up short (73 7/8...). Rule #1 cuts us all down to size Our affections seem to go in the wrong direction. This is a one way wrong. God's love for us is always on the mark but our love for Him just doesn't measure up. Rule #1 helps set us straight

## WHO GAVE THE RULE?

- Exodus 20:1 If there was a Red Letter OT this passage would be all red
  - These words weren't inspired through someone but are a DM from SOMEONE
    - These words were heard by everyone at the mountain (not like movie)
      - No intermediary just extraordinary. Ex. 19:18-19; 20:18-19
- All scripture is God's word, but these words came by a direct audible message
- These are God's rules not man's rules
  - Manmade rules are only as good as ones who made them
    - Man is no good. Man is fallible, malleable, unreliable...so are his rules
    - Man is corrupt and his rules droll...with corruption
  - God's rules rule. Transcendent, holy, right, true to the mark and unchanging
- His rules reveal how to love. God is love and His rules are what love looks like.
  - This is the heavenly standard for all earthy interaction

## THE RELATIONSHIP IN THE RULE

- 1. Exodus 20:2
  - a. This commandment is based on relationship
  - b. Gods people bear the biggest responsibility with idolatry...& all the rules on love
- 2. The rule is not just general it is personal and individual and relational
  - a. "...the LORD <u>your</u> God..." the real God is a relational God (Heb. 8:10c)
  - b. "*You* shall have..." not *y'all* but you. It is given to all but addressed to you
- 3. These rules are from a personal Creator and individual Redeemer
  - a. The nation was fresh out of 400 years of slavery. 3 months into freedom (19:1)
    - i. This is their charter from their new loving Master
  - b. God not only made us, He redeemed us, bought us, loved us, married us (you)
  - c. The God of love has some rules on how to reflect and reciprocated that love
  - d. Rule # 1 is relational. Rule #1 is personal (can't use cliché "not personal")

## <u>RULE #1</u>

Exodus 20:3 "You shall have no other gods before Me" This is personal - between you and Me

- God demands exclusivity in relationship (Matt. 10:37 even "in-laws" can't encroach)
  - In Rule #1 is that God permits no rivals in the relationship.
  - He made us, loves us, redeemed us, provides for us and want us all to Himself
- God is the Only True and Living God

- Deut. 4:39 Isaiah 43:10-11; 44:6; 45:5, 21-22 John 17:3 1 Tim. 2:5
  1 Kings 18:21 ... if Baal is god then follow him."
- All other gods are idols Psalm 96:5 1 Thess. 1:9 (repented/converted)
  - Other religions worship demons Deut. 32:16-17 1 Cor. 10:20
  - All religions are not different roads to the same god. 1 God and 1 way
  - There are many demons behind every false religion. Many lanes on broad road.
  - Debate in our state a while back over placement of 10 commands at capitol. To paraphrase Gazette – the biggest objection was with Rule #1 because it says there is only one right way and all the other ways were wrong. (no plurality/equality)
    - They understood the exclusivity of Rule #1
    - By the way, there have been satanic display during holidays in capitols
- > The best way to convey Rule #1 is to realize the exclusive marital relationship in Rule #1
  - Idolatry is spiritual adultery. If we love Him, we won't cheat on Him
  - Hosea 3:1 Ezekiel 6:9; 23:37 Jer. 3:8-9
    - Rule #1 is God is to be #1
  - Simple terms Don't screw around on God. He won't settle for the silver metal
  - Polytheism = many gods Polyamory = many lovers (both becoming popular)
    - No open marriage with God...though it is often tried
       Jer. 2:28
- > Israel had a problem with Baal. There were others but this one got them in particular
  - Baal = Master was seen as the god of the storm/rain. Fertility/life
    - Israel joined themselves to this god as a provider (agrarian society)
  - We sing "Beulah Land" = married is the word *baal* land is married=*baal*
  - They already had a Husband/Provider. Jer. 31:32 "I was a husband=baal..."
  - Idolatry is to love another/marry another/join with another / seek provision and satisfaction from another.
- Whatever or whomever has our highest love...our greatest trust...our deepest devotion, what we look to for satisfaction and provision....that is the God, or god, we serve
  - no polyamory or multiple lovers with God Matt. 6:24 (1 Kings 18:21)
  - Covetousness and greed is idolatry Eph. 5:5 Col. 3:5
  - Hedonism is idolatry 2 Tim. 3:4 our belly can be our god Phil. 3:19
- ➤ "…before Me"
  - This is more than being #1...it is where the dastardly deed is done.
    - When we break Rule #1 we break it before HIM
  - All our adulteries are done BEFORE HIM. He sees it all. It is in His face
  - We try to hide our idolatry (Ezek. 14:3) our infidelity/indiscretions/other lovers
  - We try to hide our nakedness/shame Heb. 4:13
- Rule #1 is how love for God is done
