<u>CALL to PRAYER</u> - Pray that we would be good stewards of what God has given

Ex. 20:15 - Personal Property Rights & Responsibilities

<u>Intro</u> – The Law is all about love for God & neighbor. 2nd Table focus' on how to love neighbor. #5- Authority, #6 – Dignity, #7 – Sexuality, #8 – Property. We love our neighbor by honoring what belongs to our neighbor and by acquiring our possessions in a loving way. The most basic guide for good law/government is the 2nd Table. <u>Protect life....Protect property....Punish perjury Promote family</u> & <u>Protest envy.</u> Bad gov – takes life, takes property, winks at perjury, destroys family & nourishes envy. In our personal & national life we should love (not hate) neighbor <u>Distribution</u>, <u>Acquisition</u>, <u>Compensation</u>, <u>Negotiation</u>, <u>Misappropriation</u> & <u>Restitution</u>

The DISTRIBUTION of Personal Property

1. God owns it all. 1 Cor. 10:26 Ps. 24:1 Ps. 50:12

a. Everything we have is a gift from God. James 1:17

- 2. God does not give everyone the same amount of His stuff. 1 Sam. 2:7 Deut. 8:17-18
 - a. Matt. 25:15 (some get 5...others 2...others 1) different abilities & opportunities
 - b. To whom much is given much is required (personally and nationally)
- 3. We are stewards of what God has given. Responsible for it & must give account for it
 - a. What God has given to us.... belongs to us Acts 5:4

The ACQUISITION of Personal Property

- We are to work for what we have and not be lazy 1 Thess. 4:11-12
 - We are to be diligent, and not negligent with our 5...or 2....or 1 Prov. 13:4
- Rule #8 requires us to work for what we have
 - o 2 Thess. 3:10-12 Prov. 6:6-11 Prov. 14:23 Prov. 21:25
- God made us to work. We all have work to do. We are to work to acquire what we have

COMPENSATION for Labor

- 1. Work is to be rewarded with proper pay. It is stealing to underpay your neighbor
 - a. The workman is worthy of his hire.
 - b. We are not to take advantage of neighbor Lev. 19:13
 - i. "find a Mexican" cheap labor is stealing just compensation
 - ii. James 5:4-5 *("feed the lions, ride the horses, shoot the dogs")*
- 2. It is also stealing to not be worthy of your pay. Dishonest gain
 - a. Employees can take advantage of employers as well
 - b. An honest day's work for an honest day's pay. Col. 3:22-24
 - c. "dock your pay if you slack off when the boss is off"

NEGOTIATION in Business

• "You shall not steal" is the standard for honest business practices

- Deut. 25:13-16 "it's just business, it's not personal" is immoral.
 - To take advantage of someone in buying/selling is stealing Prov. 20:14
- Excessive interest and "payday loans" steal from the poor
 - Ex. 22:25 Lev. 25:36-37 Prov. 28:8

MISAPPROPIATION of Personal Property

- 1. There are many immoral ways to acquire stuff. It involves stealing our neighbor's stuff.
 - a. Smash a grabs robberies have been in the news
 - b. Train robberies
 - c. "Shrinkage" in stores costs us all (49 billion in '17)
 - d. ever been robbed? (you feel violated)
- 2. There is a popular notion in society that stealing doesn't count if they are rich
 - a. the idea that it doesn't matter/count if they can afford it...is evil
 - i. "they have insurance"
 - b. Stealing from the rich to "give" to the poor is still stealing
 - i. Robin Hood is not a hero... he is a thief
 - c. Government says they take from the rich to give to the poor, but they also excel in stealing from the poor to give to the rich. Asset forfeiture/seizure/excessive taxes
- 3. All stealing is an affront to God & His giving and how we are to go about getting
 - a. All thieves will have to give an account
 - b. Scammers (B.L. "you should be ashamed of yourself trying to take advantage of an old woman...your dying and going hell" [hangs up])
- 4. Religion has a way of "sanctifying" stealing. Immoral getting under the guise of religion
 - a. Faith healers Greedy for unjust gain 2 Peter 2:14 (fleece the sheep)
 - i. They devour widows houses Luke 20:46-47
 - b. Religion and money are a dangerous combination.

RESTITUTION

- How do you combat stealing and punish the pilferer?
 - o Rule #8 is the first commandment that doesn't have the death penalty attached
 - Different penalty prescribed (unless steal person). Biblical remedy is *restitution*.
- Restitution not incarceration
 - o Ex. 22:1 (pay back 5x's or 4 x's) 22:4 (pay double mentioned 3 x's)
 - Trend to reduce sentencing in "small theft" (under \$800) The solution is restitution
 - Pay back double- steal 100 pay 200..... Steal car pay 2...4 or 5
 - o Making restitution is mentioned 7 times in 22:1-15 (Ezekiel 33:15)
 - Thief should pay up not be locked up. Forced to work to pay off debt
 - Eph, 4:28
 - You show repentance by restitution

Zaccheus - Luke 19:8

- Augustine "without restitution there is not remission"
- The only hope for thieves is the One who was crucified between two thieves
 - o Jesus made restitution in His work of redemption
 - o Isaiah 40:1-2 He paid double for all our sins Rock of Ages
