## Daniel 2:13-30 - Shock & Awe-some Response

<u>Intro</u> – Daniel had trials early and often in his life. A young noble carried away captive as an adolescent and castrated. Under intense pressure to conform to the culture of his imposed new environment. *Freshman year* of forced re-education – trial over how to glorify God by their food. *Sophomore year* – the king had a dream & Daniel's division of educated elites were charged with the task of not only interpreting the dream but revealing the dream. Impossible task for the experienced magicians, or the interns (like Daniel). This passage points us to God....who can do the impossible – Luke 1:37. It also shows us how to handle impossible situations. How do you respond to a tyrannical government? What do you do when your life is unjustly threatened? Tomorrow is MLKJ Day – advocated for peaceful protest. Today, on this Lord's Day, we see Daniel demonstrate how to righteously respond to an unrighteous/unjust order. *Shock & Awesome* 

## **SHOCK**

- It appears that Daniel was unaware of the Neb's dream or his deadly decree
  - o Interns & fraternity brats were not invited to the king's confab with the *Conjurers*
  - o Daniel was in the dark about being in danger
- The jackbooted thugs show up unannounced at fraternity house to kill Daniel 2:13
  - o Imagine the scene....
- The king's commander informed Daniel about the situation 2:15
  - O Daniel had already impressed some of the officials (Chief of eunuchs and a commander)
  - o Arioch was the captain of the bodyguards 2:14 lit. "chief of the slaughterers"
  - o If Daniel had impressed and befriended the chief executioner that would have been very beneficial when that guy was sent to execute him Luke 16:9
- Arioch was not rash in carrying out his duty against Daniel
  - o The other wise men/magicians were already being killed
  - o Arioch listened to the shocked and subdued Daniel ... and treaded softly
    - Good lessons here for agents of the state and recipients of the state's wrath

## AWESOME RESPONSE

Daniel's response to this unjust & deadly situation was awesome. Shock & Awesome

- 1. Wisely Daniel didn't overreact....he reacted wisely
  - a. Stressful situations can often elicit foolish & immediate overreaction & responses
  - b. Daniel 2:14 (NIV wisdom & tact NKJV counsel & wisdom)
