## Ephesians 1:3-6 - Chosen Beforehand by the Father

*Intro* - The Bible is the amazing *Book of Truth,* it tells us things we would never know otherwise. It tells us about: Creation...Fall...this life...afterlife...eternity future...eternity past before Creation Many of the truths the Bible unveils are not just enlightening but also polarizing. The truth in our text fits this category. Predestination has a bad reputation as being hard / bad / mean / unfair. Phrases like, "making us robots" or "assaulting our free will" often come out when combating it. Talking about predestination can be uncomfortable, yet ironically it is a very comforting truth. God's choice of us is exhilarating and liberating and is presented to us in scripture as a blessing. Psalm 65:4 "How blessed is the one who You choose and bring near to You to dwell in Your courts..." If the truth of God's choice of a people is troubling to you, then I hope to ease that angst & help shift your thinking. God's choice in predestination is nothing less than a great blessing (Eph. 1:3-4). It is the blessing of adoption...being adopted by a loving Father who chooses to love someone who is not His own and guarantees that that person will forever be a part of the His family.

## PREDESTINATION IS A PROMINENT TRUTH

- 1. Predestination is not an isolated topic or a small subject in scripture.
  - a. A major Biblical theme is God choosing a people for Himself, loving them, redeeming them, and eternally saving them as a testimony to His grace & mercy.
    - i. Noah and not the world.

Abram and not his family

- ii. Isaac not Ishmael
- Jacob not Esau

Israel not other nations

- Sheep not the goats iii. The Church not the world.
- Believers not unbelievers
- 2. There are over 100 specific references to God electing, choosing or predestinating people
  - a. Almost every NT book mentions this truth
- (23 out of 27???)
- big topic
- b. It is not a question whether the Bible teaches predestination & election, but rather do we believe what the Bible teaches about predestination & election.

## PREDESTINATION IS A HUMBLING TRUTH

- No other truth brings man so low and exalts God so high as the truth of predestination
  - *Predestination* = a destination that is decided beforehand.
    - man's eternal destination is decided
  - Prideful man thinks that he is sovereign and the determiner of destiny
    - (Famous poem "Invictus") "It matters not how strait the gate, how charged with punishments the scroll, I am the master of my fate; I am the captain of my
  - The Inspired Scroll says that God is the Potter, and we are the clay
- ➤ The timing of God's choice is very humbling to man.
  - o Eph. 1:4 "...before the foundation of the world..."
  - o 2 Thess. 2:13 "...God chose you from the beginning for salvation..."
  - o 2 Tim. 1:9 Rev. 17:8
- Matt. 25:34
- Predestination happened before creation.
- None of us were there

- Predestination is all about God's will, not man's will...which is very humbling to a man.
  - Eph. 1:5c Rom. 9:15-16 (NIV - human desire or effort) John 1:12-13
  - Mans choice is outside the equation of election.
    - Predestination is all about God's will. Man's will is not in play during predestination
- It is this part of predestination that rubs us the wrong way.
  - o God is the Potter, and we are the clay...but we say NO WAY! "I am the master of my..."
  - It is God's decision in predestination that causes us such great consternation.
    - Man defends his free will while denying God His free will.

## <u>PREDESTINATION IS A PRICKLY BUT PRECIOUS TRUTH</u>

- God's decision in predestination is described as an adoption.
  - Eph. 1:5

(a blessed adoption - 1:3-5)

- Adoption is a beautiful thing...
  - adults decide they want to bring a needy child into the family
  - they may choose a child out of an orphanage or an adoption agency
  - they may adopt a baby from an unwanted pregnancy...
- Love and kindness are the bookends of predestination and adoption.
  - o Eph. 1:4c-5 "in love He predestined....according to the kind intention of His will."

Deut. 7:6-8 Deut. 10:15

1 Thess. 1:4 2 Thess. 2:13

- 1 John 3:1 Predestination is all about love & kindness shown to people who don't deserve it
- Lost, abandoned and hopeless hellions being brought into the heavenly family.
- Orphans of sin & Satan adopted & guaranteed a forever home with the Father.
  - Sinners predestined to adopted as sons
  - Predestination is a promise to love/redeem/embrace/keep for eternity
    - Predestination is a guaranteed & pre-arranged place in the home
- Who makes the decision in an adoption?
  - The adult decides to love and adopt. The child is the recipient of the loving action of the adult
  - In both birth & adoption the child is not the one making the choice of family.
    - None of us chooses the family we are born in or adopted into.
  - God chooses to make us His children by new birth & adoption...He pre-chooses
  - No one faults a parent for not adopting all the orphans.
    - Why blame God for graciously choosing some and not all?
    - He didn't save any fallen angels but has chosen to save many fallen men.
- What predestination is not
  - o Predestination is not forcing people kicking and screaming into heaven while turning people away who want to be a part of the heavenly family
  - Matt. 11:25-28 *Election* and an *Open Invitation* are not incompatible truths o John 6:37
- Can I know if I have been chosen? YES!
  - 2 Peter 1:10 Titus 1:1 Acts 13:48
  - In God's amazing predestination everyone gets exactly what they want
    - The unbeliever willing rebels/rejects. The believer willing embraces Christ.
  - The believer eventually finds out that we love Him because He loved us first.
    - # 289 in blue hymnal "My Lord, I did not choose You, for that could never be..."
