## **Prophecy & The Pecking Order**

- Going to look at OT prophecies about Christ's first coming and then the pecking order of events around His birth, infancy and childhood.
  - The traditional narrative doesn't always fit the biblical narrative

## OT PROPHECY (about birth/infancy)

- The birth of the Savior / Messiah virgin born
  - o Genesis 3:15 Seed of the woman
    - Skeptics say that Christianity "stole" the story of a virgin birth because of the many other (older) religions that have miraculously born gods
      - The opposite is true you can't get much older than Gen. 3 (only 2 people on planet)
      - Satan has corrupted the true message with his false ones
        - o All other religions are satanic deception
    - Even the constellations have been co-opted and corrupted
      - <u>Virgo</u> virgin carrying seed (seed of the woman) and a "branch" Is. 11 Zech 6
      - <u>Scorpio</u> under one foot of the Mighty One stinger at other foot
        - o the constellation displays the content of Genesis 3:15
      - <u>Sagittarius</u> one with two natures with arrow pointed at Scorpio
      - *Aries* the lamb binding the great sea monster Cetus
      - <u>Leo</u> the Lion with multi-headed dragon Hydra under His feet
  - o Isaiah 7:14 (Matt. 1:22-23)
  - O Psalm 22:9-10 Isaiah 49:1 (named from the womb Matt. 1:20-21) Isaiah 49:5
- From the seed of Israel
  - o Seed of Abraham Gal. 3:16 (several references to this in Genesis)
  - o Seed of David Jer. 23:5-6 Isaiah 11:1-5
- Star that points to the King from Judah
  - O Numbers 24:17 Star & scepter (a star to announce The King)

• Place of birth and residence

Born in Bethlehem. Grew up in Egypt. Landed in

Nazareth

- o Micah 5:2
- o Hosea 11:2
- Isaiah 11:1 (HEB = "nay-tser" / branch) ??? this Hebrew word sounds like Nazar-ene Matt. 2:23
- Gifts brought on camels from people of the east

O Isaiah 60:6 ??? (Matt. 2:11) (donkeys not mentioned but camels are)

- Timeframe in history
  - o Daniel 9:25-26
- God has an eternal Son who He will send. The eternally begotten will be begot in time
- o Prov. 30:4 Isaiah 9:6-7 Psalm 2 Micah 5:2 (Gal. 4:4)
- Slaughter of the children in Bethlehem
  - o Jer. 31:15 (Rachel died in Bethlehem giving birth Gen. 35:19)

## **PECKING ORDER OF EVENTS**

- 1. Gabriel announces to Mary about virgin conception (Nazareth) Luke 1:26-38
- 2. Mary visits Elizabeth (who was 6 months pregnant with John) (Judea hills) Luke 1:39-56
  - a. Stayed 3 months (until John is born...then returned home to Nazareth)
- 3. Joseph contemplates divorcing Mary Matt. 1:18-25 (after 3 months showing ?? telling Joseph??)
  - a. Angelic visit in a dream
  - b. Name of Jesus given by angel
- 4. Travel to Bethlehem for census Luke 2:1-5
- 5. Birth in Bethlehem Luke 2:6-7
- 6. Angelic glory seen at night by the shepherds Luke 2:8-9
  - a. This light show was probably seen by the Magi in the east which started their preparation for the journey to Jerusalem (star) angels shining ones/stars Job 38:7 Rev. 12:3-4
  - b. Probably not in the winter time
    - i. shepherds in field at night ...and... travel for census (probably Spring or Summer)
- 7. Shepherds informed Luke 2:10-14
- 8. Shepherds visit the manger the night of birth Luke 2:15-16
- 9. Shepherds spread the word Luke 2:17-20
- 10. At eight days old Jesus was circumcised and named Luke 2:21

- 11. A forty days old Jesus was taken to the Temple in Jerusalem for the ceremonial cleansing
  - a. Luke 2:22-38

(Lev. 12)

(8 days & 40 days are usually left out of story)

12. Some point between 40 days and 2 years old:

Matt. 2

- a. The Magi show up to Jerusalem (not 3 men but 3 gifts) (300 men?)
- b. Many Magi stir Jerusalem with their questions Matt. 2:2-3
  - i. (again...3 guys wouldn't make much of a stir in Jerusalem) "we 3 Kings = tradition
  - ii. The Magi want to know where King Messiah is to be born
- c. Herod's inquisition

Matt. 2:4-8

d. Star is seen and is over the *HOUSE* (the star is an angel)

Matt. 2:9-10

- i. The Magi went to a house, not the manger (they showed much later than the shepherds ?2 yrs?)
- e. Gifts

Matt. 2:11

Isaiah 60:6

- i. 3 gifts not 3 kings
- 13. Magi warned in a dream not to return to Herod go home another way

  2:12
- 14. Joseph warned in a dream to flee

Matt. 2:13

- 15. Joseph takes his family **that night** and flees to Egypt . Matt. 2:14 (pregnant & on the move again! ©)
  - a. The gifts of Magi funded their impromptu move
    - i. Like Israel plundering the Egyptians as they left Egypt
- 16. They lived in Egypt for a while Matt. 2:15 (did they have other kids there??? Matt. 13:55-56)
- 17. Herod slaughters the boys around Bethlehem 2 years old and younger.

  2:16-18

  Matt.
  - a. Time determined from the info from the Magi
- 18. Angel appears to Joseph in Egypt to tell him Herod is dead

Matt. 2:19-20

- 19. Joseph moves his family to Nazareth sometime between when Jesus was 2- 12 Matt. 2:21-23
- 20. At 12 the family goes from Nazareth to Jerusalem Luke 2:41-52
