<u>CALL to PRAYER</u> - Ask God to increase your faith - strength & amount

<u>Intro</u> - This is our fourth message defining faith. Initially we dissected faith and noted the three essential ingredients in *saving faith*. Then we observed what *true faith* looks like as opposed to a *false faith* and distinguished between *saving faith* & one that doesn't save. Last week we focused on the origin of *saving faith*. Faith is not something a sinner can conjure up by his own will; it is "not of ourselves it is the gift of God." Jesus is the Author & finisher of our faith. God enables us to believe; He grants belief as a gift of His grace. It you have faith then you need to thank God for the ability to believe. Today we explore the practical question of "how do I get more faith?" We need faith and we need more of it. And lest you think we can be passive in this and say "Well, if it is a gift of God then maybe God didn't give me very much." Well even if that is so - a little goes along way. Just a speck can accomplish spectacular things. Believers have the responsibility to use our faith, grow our faith & exercise our faith…all the while asking God for more faith. The passage I am about to read records an instance where the disciples ask Jesus for more faith. As we learn what our most holy faith requires of us…it will show us our need for more faith.

Luke 17:1-10 - Definitions 9 - Increasing Your Faith

THE NEED FOR MORE FAITH

• Our environment, requirement, and enslavement demonstrate our need for more faith

0	Environment -	(Luke 17:1-2)	the inevitability of sin
0	Requirement -	(Luke 17:3-6)	giving personal forgiveness
0	Enslavement -	(Luke 17:7-10)	as Christ's slaves we must serve

- Forgiveness
 - Jesus tells His disciple the Christian requirement for personal forgiveness
 - Rebuke your brother...forgive your repentant brother...7 times a day!
 - o When they hear this, they ask for more faith Luke 17:5
 - o Christian standards should make us clamor for more faith
 - we need faith to live & forgive in this sinful world. We are sinners who sin and are sinned against
- Enslavement Luke 17:10
 - We need more faith to fulfill our duties as Christ's slaves in this sinful world

HOW DO I INCREASE MY FAITH?

Ask for it Luke 17:5

Jesus is the *Author* of faith Heb. 12:2 so we should ask Him for more of it. (James 4:2b)

Cultivate it Jesus compared faith to a seed

o Luke 17:6 Plant it...water it...give it plenty of SONshine. Cultivate it!

o Don't use the excuse that the faith God gave you is small (limited)

God has given you a measure of faith - Rom. 12:3
 Use it - Rom. 12:6

A little goes a long way. Just a speck can be spectacular - Luke 17:6

- ➤ We can learn to cultivate faith by examples Jesus called out as *great faith or little faith*
 - Where Jesus pointed out "great faith" is where we find out how to cultivate faith
 Emulate great faith
- Matt. 8:5-9
 - o This soldier understood *Authority* and *Giving Orders* to servants
 - o The centurion acknowledged that sickness is but a servant of Jesus. Jesus is Lord!
 - Jesus said that was great faith Matt. 8:10
 - An opposite example is given in Matt. 8:25-27 (little faith)
 - Jesus rebuked their thinking that the storm operated independent of God
- Do you acknowledge Christ's sovereignty over sickness and storms?
 - o <u>Great faith</u> = Christ commands them <u>Little faith</u> they operate independent
 - Belief in God's sovereignty will cultivate your faith
- ➤ The more we know the more we can grow 2 Peter 3:18
 - o We cannot and do not limit God...but a limited view of God will limit our faith
 - Omniscience (if only God knew) Omnipotence (if only God could)
 Omnipresence (if only He were here) Sovereignty (God doesn't govern)
- Matt. 15:28 (15:21-28)
 - This desperate mother dug deep for her faith...and it was great
 - o Jesus gave her a hard saying...insulted her Matt. 15:24-26
 - She accepted His hard saying and applied faith to it
 Matt. 15:27
 - "Yes Lord! I am a dog but even the dogs get some crumbs, can I have a crumb?"
- ➤ How do you handle the hard sayings of Scripture? Accept or reject?
 - O Some of God's words are a *deal breaker* for some people. (they won't plant/cultivate)
 - o Jesus' teaching on salvation offended many. John 6:60, 65-66
 - o Is there a passage of scripture you are prejudiced against? biased against parts of Bible
 - Jehoiakim's scribe knife (Jer. 36)
 He cut out the part he didn't like
 - Many people do the same with Biblical history....morality...&... theology
 - We may not understand it (struggle with it) but should not reject it John 6:67-68
 - The Bible steps on all our toes.
 Do we move toes or move Bible?
 - If you want to grow your faith, then you need to believe some hard things
 - Hold it in tension...but don't deny it or be ashamed of it (Mark 8:38)
- Trials are the training ground for your faith
 - Your faith is exercised when it pushed. (no pain no gain)
 - Faith muscles only grow under pressure...and strain...and consistent use
 - o James 1:2-4 (1 Peter 1:6-7) God will give you problems to produce a stronger faith
 - o James 2:5 (Rev. 2:9)
 - God chose to give the poor Christian a lot of faith to go with a lot of problems
 - Difficulties can deepen faith.
 Difficulty does a faith good
 - Difficulty is an opportunity for your faith to grow
- ➤ How do you increase Faith?
 - o Ask for it. Cultivate it. Believe is big God (sovereign)

Believe hard things. Endure hard things
